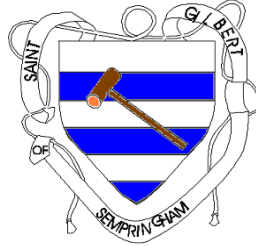

We have a very busy half term with lots of events on the horizon. Please keep checking twitter and the website calendar for more information.

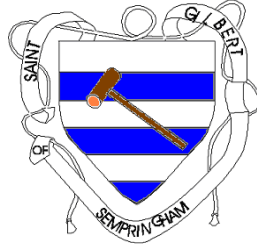

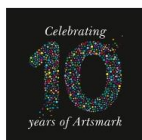
