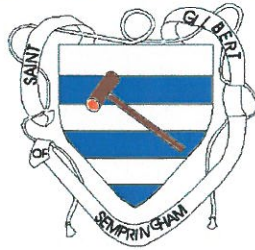

Dear Parents and Families,

Our Summer Fayre is fast approaching and we thought it would be a good idea to remind families of the key dates and requests associated with it. It promises to be an exciting community event with lots of varied stalls and activities and we hope everyone in our school community can come along to support to raise money for school funds.

The Fayre is on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July at 2pm. Please collect your children from class at 2pm to attend the Fayre. If you are unable to collect your child, please let Miss Tumelty know in advance so that arrangements can be made. The close of the school day will be 3.15pm and there is no aftercare on this day.

We will be having two non-uniform days in support of the Fayre. The first is on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June. We ask on this day that your child brings a bottle for the bottle tombola. It can be anything in a bottle – wine, bubble bath etc. As Year 1 and 2 are on a day trip on this day, their bring a bottle day will be Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June whilst their non uniform day will be the day of the Cbeebies trip. The second non-uniform day is the day of the Fayre, the 7<sup>th</sup> July. We ask on this day that KS1 bring a filled jar ( extra details on the reverse of this letter ).We ask that KS2 bring in cake for the refreshment stall.

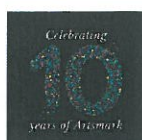

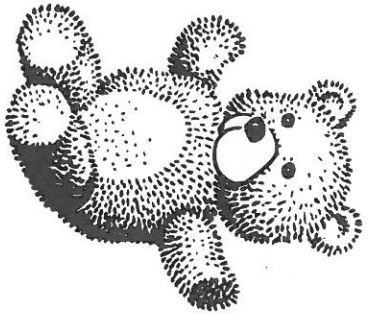
Parents Forum request that any parents who would wish to help to set the Fayre up, to let Mrs Hickey know.
